Training Therapists since 1957, the Escola Superior de Saúde do Alcoitão (ESSAlcoitão) / Alcoitão School of Health Sciences is a benchmark in the Portuguese and international landscape. The Undergraduate, Master and Post-graduate degrees in Speech Therapy, Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy include partnerships in 17 countries and worldwide recognition, with our professionals working all around the world. The Santa Casa da Misericórdia de Lisboa (SCML), as the founding body, represents the main assurance of the stability and quality of the educational project that has been achieved throughout the existence of ESSAlcoitão. The SCML is a non-profitable institution of public utility, founded over 500 year ago, with activities in the field of solidarity, social services and health.

MAIN INTERESTS AND GOALS FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

Our main interests and goals for cooperation with institutions from the U.S., can be set on two levels: a first regarding exchange of students. This allows American students to study in Portugal, and Portuguese students in the U.S.; on the other hand, the possibility of being able to develop future degrees in these areas of studies; in a worldwide view there is a long path to be walked in these particular scientific areas, as they haven't yet been totally explored, presenting themselves as a challenge. The acknowledgment of our courses by international professional organizations allows our alumni to aim for a job market that comprehends not only the E.U., but also the U.S. This should be particularly relevant for both parties, meaning that any cooperation will be a sure success for assuring job opportunities for those who seek a higher education and something to consider, and a starting point market of 800M. When besides that, you cooperate with the most credited school in the area in Portugal, as well as the first in a country with such a great connection with all the Portuguese speaking countries this rises job opportunities not only to Europe and North America, but also, Africa, Asia and South America; not only is ESSAlcoitão willing to cooperate with U.S. institutions, we have a 60 year back round experience in these specific areas; were we the first to teach them in Portugal, but we also took them to Mozambique (in a partnership with ISCISA). Our goal: to find an ambitious and accredited partner to aim to rise higher than before, taking Physiotherapy, Occupational and Speech Therapy, to a new level of knowledge, in its own doctoral area needed worldwide.

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INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

Lusíada University, founded in 1986, is one of the oldest Portuguese private university and is a historical reference in the movement that has propelled consolidated and valued private education in the Portuguese university system. From an early age it gained a national and international dimension, with university centers operating in the two main Portuguese cities (Lisbon and Porto) and in the northern city of V.N. Famalicão, where it installed an essentially technological university campus. At present, Lusíada University is attended by about 6000 students in all three cycles of study and have a significant body of more than 500 highly qualified teachers. All undergraduate, masters and doctoral courses were subject of rigorous and demanding evaluation processes by the National Agency for the Evaluation of Higher Education (A3 ES), being duly accredited.

Consistent with this line of action, its research unit, VALORIZA has as main objective the promotion of applied research activities based on experimental development and on knowledge production and transfer, with potential impact on territorial development processes and dynamics. Study in Portugal Network (SiPN) is a specialized study abroad provider based in Lisbon, Portugal, created and managed by FLAD - a major Portuguese Foundation whose mission is to promote the development of Portugal through bilateral relations with the United States. SiPN is a multi-university consortium of Lisbon-based universities: ISCTE-Instituto Universitário de Lisboa, Universidade Católica Portuguesa, Universidade de Lisboa and Universidade Nova de Lisboa that aims to attract and support students and faculty from the United States to come to Portugal on various study abroad experiences.

Since 2016, SiPN also established a summer program in partnership with the University of the Azores.

SiPN offers semester and summer study abroad programs, including research and internship opportunities. Additionally, each year we welcome in Portugal a large number of short-term faculty-led programs tailored to the needs and requirements of the program director and the respective home university in the United States.
