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THE ERASMUS + EDUCATION AND TRAINING PORTUGUESE NATIONAL AGENCY (PORTUGUESE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND INNOVATION)

The primary mission of the Erasmus+ Education and Training Portuguese National Agency is to oversee the Erasmus+ program across various sectors, including school education, vocational education and training, higher education, and adult education within Portugal. Additionally, it plays a pivotal role in coordinating efforts to internationalize Portuguese education and training.

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LUSO-AMERICAN DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION

The Luso-American Development Foundation (FLAD) is a private, non-profit, financially independent Portuguese institution.

Its main goal is to contribute towards Portugal's development by providing financial and strategic support for innovative projects by fostering cooperation between Portugal and the USA.

Since 2014, FLAD also operates its own study abroad program, the Study in Portugal Network – The gateway for US Higher Education to study abroad in Portugal.

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FULBRIGHT COMMISSION PORTUGAL

The Fulbright Commission Portugal was created in 1960 through a diplomatic agreement signed between the Portuguese Government and the Government of the United States of America. Since then the Commission has been administering the Fulbright Program of Educational Exchange in Portugal. In 2015 a new agreement was signed between the U.S. and Portugal, which contributed to the reinforcement of cooperation in the areas of education and science between the two countries, within the scope of the Fulbright Commission activity. The Fulbright Commission has developed an important role in the promotion of mutual understanding between the USA and Portugal, through its triple mission in the areas of education and science:

- offering opportunities for the exchange of scholars, researchers and students;
- delivering quality orientation and information services focused on the educational systems of both countries; and
- organizing knowledge-sharing initiatives.

The Fulbright Commission has been deeply involved in the activities developed by Portuguese higher education institutions to attract U.S. students, scholars and researchers and supports them in their internationalization strategies concerning the U.S.. The Commission lead the efforts to establish a sustained representation of the Portuguese Higher Education and Research system at NAFSA and has been part of the organizing committee of the Study and Research in Portugal delegation at NAFSA for the last years.

Fernando Pessoa Education and Culture Foundation is the institution responsible for the Fernando Pessoa University, the Fernando Pessoa Hospital, and the Fernando Pessoa School of Health. The Foundation (FFP) aims to develop activities promoting education, teaching, culture, scientific research, professional and corporate training, and public health. The Foundation's objectives also include health education and healthcare provision, environmental protection, and community outreach. Its main areas of activity are science, healthcare and medical services, and education. Universidade Fernando Pessoa was recognized as a public interest organization by the Portuguese State in July 1996 and it is the result of a pioneering higher education project initiated in the 1980's with the creation of two higher education institutes that provided its structural basis. Today, the University has around five thousand students and is organized in three faculties (Health Sciences, Human and Social Sciences, Science and Technology), one School of Health Sciences and one autonomous unit (Ponte de Lima College). It has managed to develop into a solid private higher education institution with a strong academic focus and a constant concern with quality maintenance and improvement in what concerns its teaching, research and extension project.

The University of Coimbra (UC) is a Portuguese public university with more than 730 years of history. It was the only Portuguese-speaking university until the 20th century, and it has been asserting its position ever since, with a unique mix of tradition, modernity and innovation, being classified as World Heritage by UNESCO.

With more than 25.000 students in all programmes, UC is an excellent multicultural interface between Portuguese language speakers and the rest of the world, being part of international networks like EC2U “European Campus of City-Universities”, an European Universities Alliance Group.

Strongly committed to the UN 2030 Agenda Sustainable Development Goals, UC is the 26th most sustainable university in the world, according to the THE Ranking 2022, and the most sustainable nationwide and the most sustainable in the Union European.

Particular reference should be made to the Erasmus programme, including the EC2U European Alliance and the Erasmus Mundus action, and to the Santander Totta scholarship programme.

A significant part of the international dimension of the UC lies in its participation in international cooperation networks. Thus, the Coimbra Group network is of the utmost importance. It is also important to mention other networks such as the European University Association, the Utrecht Network, the SYLFF Network, the Asociación Universitaria Iberoamericana de Postgrado and the Associação de Universidades de Língua Portuguesa. 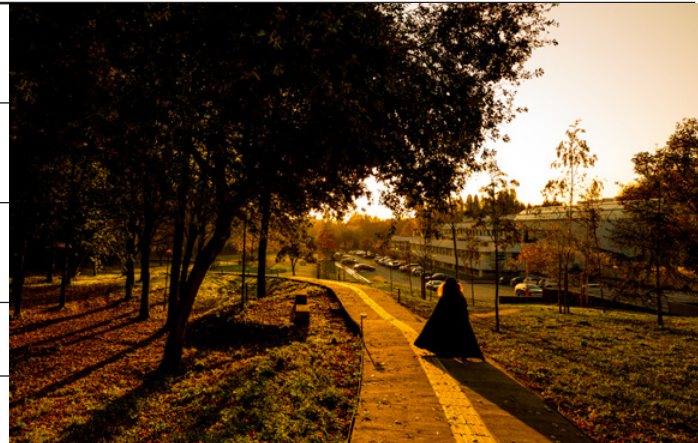
