INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

Located in Oeiras, in the historic Fábrica da Pólvora de Barcarena campus, Atlântica – Instituto Universitário (University Institute) has distinguished itself for almost three decades with an innovative teaching model that combines academic rigour and research opportunities with a strong connection to the business fabric and realities. Atlântica's educational offer includes several bachelor's degrees, four master's degrees and two doctorates in the areas of Engineering, Business Sciences and Nutrition. It also stands out as the only private entity in Portugal offering a degree in Aeronautical Engineering and is part of the group of 135 entities that make up the AED - Cluster for the Aeronautics, Space and Defence industries. study plans, such as the Physiotherapy degree, which each year welcomes more than 100 international students who need to complete the practical component of their courses and trust ESSATLA to do so.

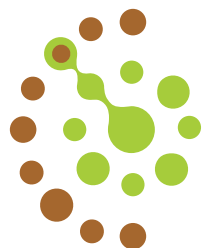


INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

The Polytechnic University of Beja (IPBeja) is a public higher education institution founded in 1979, located in the south of Portugal, in the Alentejo region, 180 km from the capital city — Lisbon.

IPBeja is made up four Schools – the School of Agriculture, the School of Education, the School of Health, and the School of Technology and Management. It offers 50 different academic and training programmes, covering undergraduate, master and professional levels. The education areas are the following: Agronomy, Environmental Engineering, Food Sciences, Bioanalytical Technologies, Education, Social Work, Arts and Multimedia, Sports, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Management, Tourism, Computer Sciences and Attorneyship. IPBeja offers several international learning and training programs, including course units taught in English and specific programs for international staff.

INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

Polytechnic University of Coimbra (IPC) was created in 1979 and is located in the central region of Portugal in the city of Coimbra, which has been known for centuries as the “city of students”. Presently IPC is one of the ten largest Portuguese higher education institutions (HEI) with a major role in the development of the region and the progress of the country. IPC is composed by six schools with about 12500 students and 1330 employees (teachers and staff). IPC Schools offer higher education programmes in many fields of study such as agricultural sciences, education and arts, administration, marketing and business sciences, media and communications sciences, tourism and sports, gastronomy, health technologies and engineering. All schools offer programmes of several levels of qualification, namely, Higher Professional Technical Courses, bachelor’s degrees, master’s degrees and postgraduate education and most recently a PhD in Agri-Food and Environmental Sustainability, and a UNIgreen Joint PhD in Agri-Food Science, Technology and Biotechnology. IPC develops high quality applied research in several of its subjects in its different schools. The dimension of scientific research has been increasingly valued in recent years, through the Institute for Applied Research (IIA) with the main goal of integrate and rationalize the scientific resources and to develop applied research and transfer knowledge and technology to industry and community, promoting innovation in processes, products, and services, and several laboratories of R&D and also through INOPOL Entrepreneurship Academy, a functional unit of the Polytechnic of Coimbra whose mission is to promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship and to foster the creation and growth of new startup and spinoff companies with a scientific basis and innovative nature.

MAIN INTERESTS AND GOALS FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

Internationalization represents a crucial policy in the governance of the Polytechnic of Coimbra and is aligned with the strategic framework of European cooperation in the field of education and training.

The priorities in this area include strengthening the institution’s international position, with a particular focus on Portuguese-speaking countries and Latin America, and capturing new lines and opportunities available in European programs.

International mobility and international cooperation projects constitute the two main axes of consolidation and reinforcement of the institution’s internationalization and are transversal to the activities of teaching, research and interaction with society. The Polytechnic of Coimbra has several mobility programs that support its students, and also teachers and non-teachers, in the realization of international experiences. In addition to opportunities for study periods or internships and teaching or training missions in the European space, through the well-known Erasmus+, the institution also offers grants to support international mobility in multiple countries outside Europe, namely, and among others, through the International Credit Mobility (ICM), IPC Latin America and AULP Mobility programs.

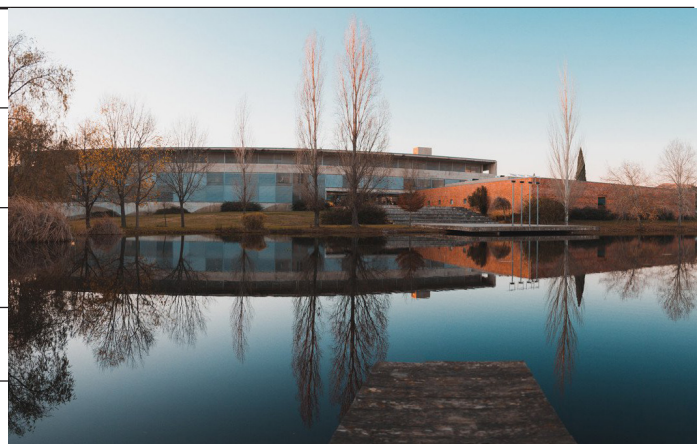

The Portalegre Polytechnic University is a public Higher Education institution which includes the School of Education and Social Sciences, the School of Technology, Management and Design, the School of Health, in Portalegre, and the School of Biosciences, in Elvas.

The Polytechnic University of Viseu (IPV) is a prominent public institution of Higher Education located in the central region of Portugal, and it plays a pivotal role in the skilling, upskilling and reskilling of the local population. 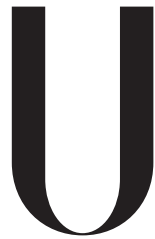

With more than 700 Erasmus agreements and around 200 bilateral agreements with HEI’s around the World, the UC spreads its influence and lets itself be influenced by the best practices. Classified with 5 stars in internationalisation by the QS Stars University Ratings and with more than 20% of international students, the UC functions as a unique interface between the Portuguese language and the rest of the world, with a growing Alumni network.

The UC encourages the internationalisation of its students and staff by promoting opportunities for the enhancement of the professional and cultural experience in studying, teaching, researching and management of international relations. Particular reference should be made to the Erasmus programme, including the EC2U European Alliance and the Erasmus Mundus action, and to the Santander Totta scholarship programme.

A significant part of the international dimension of the UC lies in its participation in international cooperation networks. Thus, the Coimbra Group network is of the utmost importance. It is also important to mention other networks such as the European University Association, the Utrecht Network, the SYLFF Network, the Asociación Universitaria Iberoamericana de Postgrado and the Associação de Universidades de Língua Portuguesa. INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

The School of Arts and Humanities is the third largest of the eighteen schools of the University of Lisbon and ranked #1 Portuguese Faculty in Humanities. It was founded in 1911, from a course that existed since 1859. 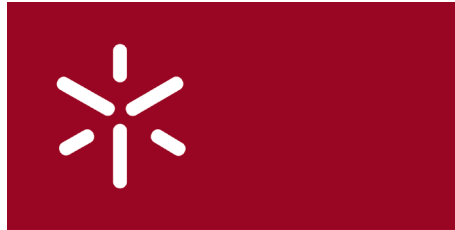
