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INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

Located in Oeiras, in the historic Fábrica da Pólvora de Barcarena campus, Atlântica – Instituto Universitário (University Institute) has distinguished itself for almost three decades with an innovative teaching model that combines academic rigour and research opportunities with a strong connection to the business fabric and realities. Atlântica's educational offer includes several bachelor's degrees, four master's degrees and two doctorates in the areas of Engineering, Business Sciences and Nutrition. It also stands out as the only private entity in Portugal offering a degree in Aeronautical Engineering and is part of the group of 135 entities that make up the AED - Cluster for the Aeronautics, Space and Defence industries. Lusíada University, founded in 1986, is one of the oldest Portuguese private university and is a historical reference in the movement that has propelled consolidated and valued private education in the Portuguese university system. From an early age it gained a national and international dimension, with university centers operating in the two main Portuguese cities (Lisbon and Porto) and in the northern city of V.N. Famalicão, where it installed an essentially technological university campus.

At present, Lusíada University is attended by about 6000 students in all three cycles of study and have a significant body of more than 500 highly qualified teachers.

All undergraduate, masters and doctoral courses were subject of rigorous and demanding evaluation processes by the National Agency for the Evaluation of Higher Education (A3 ES), being duly accredited.

Lusíada University is a member of the European University Association (EUA), an organization that brings together the main universities (public and private) of the countries of the European Union, and a member of the Portuguese Association of Private Higher Education (APESP), one of the founders of the European Union of Private Higher Education (EUPHE).

The dimension of scientific research has been increasingly valued in recent years, and the following centers operate: CEJEA (Center for Economic and Environmental Legal Studies), COMEGI (Center for Research in Organizations, Markets and Industrial Management), CITAD (Territorial Research, Environment and Design), CIPD (Center for Research in Psychology and Development), CLIPIS (Center for Research on International and Security Policy) and CLISIS (Center for Research in Social Work).

Polytechnic University of Coimbra (IPC) was created in 1979 and is located in the central region of Portugal in the city of Coimbra, which has been known for centuries as the "city of students". IPC is composed by six schools with about 12500 students and 1330 employees (teachers and staff). All schools offer programmes of several levels of qualification, namely, Higher Professional Technical Courses, bachelor's degrees, master's degrees and postgraduate education and most recently a PhD in Agri-Food and Environmental Sustainability, and a UNIgreen Joint PhD in Agri-Food Science, Technology and Biotechnology. IPC develops high quality applied research in several of its subjects in its different schools. The dimension of scientific research has been increasingly valued in recent years, through the Institute for Applied Research (IIA) with the main goal of integrate and rationalize the scientific resources and to develop applied research and transfer knowledge and technology to industry and community, promoting innovation in processes, products, and services, and several laboratories of R&D and also trough INOPOL Entrepreneurship Academy, a functional unit of the Polytechnic of Coimbra whose mission is to promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship and to foster the creation and growth of new startup and spinoff companies with a scientific basis and innovative nature.

Internationalization represents a crucial policy in the governance of the Polytechnic of Coimbra and is aligned with the strategic framework of European cooperation in the field of education and training.

The priorities in this area include strengthening the institution's international position, with a particular focus on Portuguese-speaking countries and Latin America, and capturing new lines and opportunities available in European programs.

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
INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION



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


INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION




